Program Description

Felony Sentencing 101 is the basics of felony sentencing. Mr. Camacho will discuss felony probation, basic felony sentencing rules such as how to calculate maximum sentences and how to determine where they're served (prison v. county jail), and the strike law to explain what are strikes and how sentencing works for strikes.

The additional trainings get into the gun and gang enhancements, one-strike sex crimes, issues regarding consecutive and concurrent sentencing, and how to sentence in "mixed sentencing" cases, where the defendant is being sentenced to determinate and indeterminate sentences in the same proceeding.

Speaker

Albert Camacho, Los Angeles County Deputy Public Defender - Mr. Camacho has worked as a Deputy Public Defender in LA County for 27+ years. He has extensive trial and appellate court experience, and is currently assigned to the Immigration Unit, where he advises fellow attorneys on the immigration consequences of proposed criminal plea bargains and provides in-house training in this complex area of criminal law.

Mr. Camacho has been providing felony sentencing trainings in LA for about 10 years. He is a member of the ExCom of the Criminal Law Section of the California Lawyers Association. He is quite familiar with providing trainings for mixes of defense and prosecution.

Mr. Camacho has spoken at the CLA Annual Meeting on the intersection of criminal and family law in domestic violence cases. He has also been a CLE presenter at LACBA events.
